To ensure the best meeting experience, please abide by the following guidelines:

Table-Number Draw Process:

Members are to sit according to their table number drawn. Refrain from switching numbers, tables, or searching in the basket for a matching number to sit with friends. Members needing to be accompanied due to medical conditions will be accommodated.

Respectful Interaction:

Everyone's journey is different. Engage in conversations with kindness, respect, and empathy. Aim to support each other by being open-minded, compassionate, and helpful.

Confidentiality:
